Released for pilot testing

- · OVC's role
  - Competitively funded this project in 2017 under its first Field-Generated Innovations in Addressing Elder Abuse and Financial Exploitation Program solicitation (one of several national-scope projects funded by OVC under this program)
  - Federal grant-making authority to issue and monitor grants and cooperative agreements under the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA)
  - Once evaluated, draft materials to be finalized and submitted to OVC for final approval and dissemination
